Statement of Purpose (SOP)	YES	12-Midnight (PST) on December 15

APPLICATION TIMELINE

September	All GRE and TOEFL tests should be taken in early fall to ensure a timely submission.
December 15	Application deadline for M.S., M.S./Ph.D. and Ph.D. programs (all supporting materials must be received).
Early April	Target date for all applicants to be notified of admissions decisions. All admissions decisions will be communicated via email.
April 15	Must submit Statement of Intent to Register (SIR) for prospective students receiving fellowship or financial offers.
Early May	Admission decisions posted on the Graduate Application Status Page
June 15	Deadline to submit Statement of Intent to Register (SIR).
